

Where do your contributions go? Contributions to the

- General Operating Fund are used to support the church's staff, programs, worship & music, building and operational costs.
- **Per Capita** is used to pay the PC(USA)'s annual assessment, which is \$29 per adult church member. The PC(USA) uses these funds to support the expenses of the presbytery, synod and general assembly.
- Deacon's Fund monies are used to provide basics (like food, gas, temporary housing/housing costs) to needy individuals in our local community.
- Concert Series Fund monies are used to enhance the cultural arts in our church by bringing local, national and international performers to FPC.
- **First Endowment Fund** monies are invested, and the income from those investments is used to support the church's operating budget and for First Foundation's benevolence grants which are made to FPC's mission outreach programs, local and international charities, and theological, interfaith, and diversity oriented causes.
- First Music Fund monies are invested and the income from that investment is used to enhance the music ministry at FPC.
